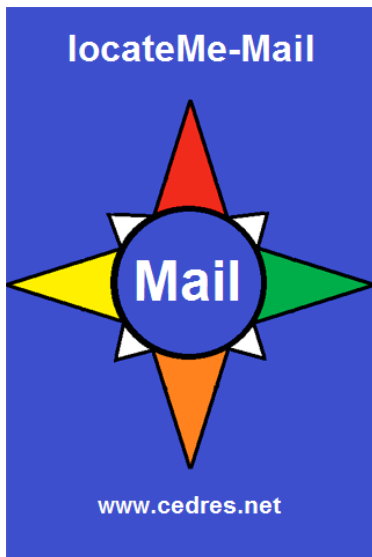


locateMe-Mail

locateMe-Mail allows sending email in an automated way.

The message includes two parts :

- A predetermined part by the user (=> "settings").
- A part added by ***locateMe-Mail*** that includes the position of the user at the time of the sending :
 - o Geographical coordinates according to two formats : dd (decimal degrees) and dms (degrees, minutes, seconds) and precision of the position (meters).
 - o Link to Google Maps plan centered on the position.

The main users of *locateMe-Mail* are:

- Walkers and hikers in difficulty who can thus transmit their position in an easy way.
- Hikers who want to note in a simple way points of passage (waypoint) which mark out their course.
- Private individuals who want to give each other appointment in a mysterious and amusing way.

- ***locateMe-Mail*** works with **iPhone OS 3.0** and later.

- the user must have configured his iPhone to send e-mails

use of *locateMe-Mail* :

- 1- **At the first start**, screen 4 (settings) is presented. It allows initializing the addresses of the recipients as well as the fixed part of the message .
Warning, the application makes all possible controls nevertheless it is recommended to be particularly attentive while entering the email addresses
It is possible to modify this information at any time by pressing on the button "new settings" of screen 2.

- 2- **During the activation of the application :**
 - screen 1 then screen 2 appears during five seconds

 - Then the screen 3 is displayed, it allows sending the message.
It includes:
 - multiple recipients (1 ou 2).
 - the predefined text of the message
 - localization data

 - The user can then :
 - modify the message if he wishes it.
 - send the message (« send »).
 - **or** cancel the sending (« cancel »).

- 3- Once the message is sent or cancelled, screen 2 is displayed again.
The user can :
 - terminate the application (« home » button).
 - or resend the message (« retry »)
